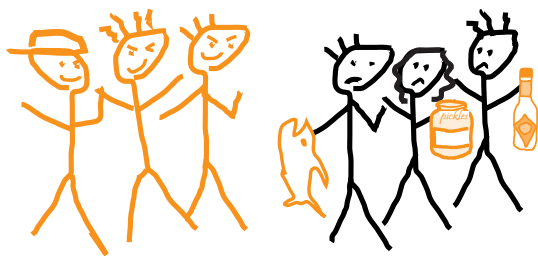

here!"



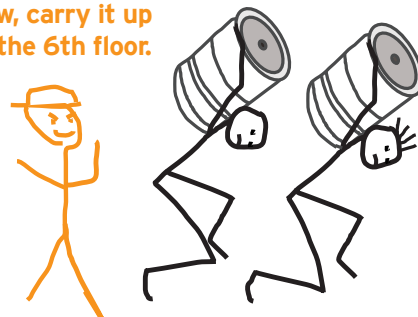
... not in a
